



SAFEGUARDING POLICY - 2

Agreed by ManCom.....September 2009

Note 1 – This statement and recommendation was issued to all NYSMBA clubs in September 2009 together with a Notice of Child and Vulnerable Adult Policy; notes regarding Child Protection Officers (CPOs) and CRB checks; some frequently asked questions (FAQs) and a Parent/Carers Consent Form (PCF). These documents have now been added to the Policy Register as Safeguarding Policies 1 and 3-5 respectively.

At the 2010 AGM the Association made the following addition to its Constitution in line with ESMBA recommendations.

“The Association is committed to promoting a safe environment in which children and vulnerable adults can enjoy taking part in games of bowls.

It will seek to underpin and ensure this commitment by following and promoting the principles of the joint Child Protection Policy issued by the English Bowls National Governing Bodies (NGBs).”

The Association strongly recommends that a similarly worded amendment should be adopted by all member clubs in their own Club constitutions/rules
